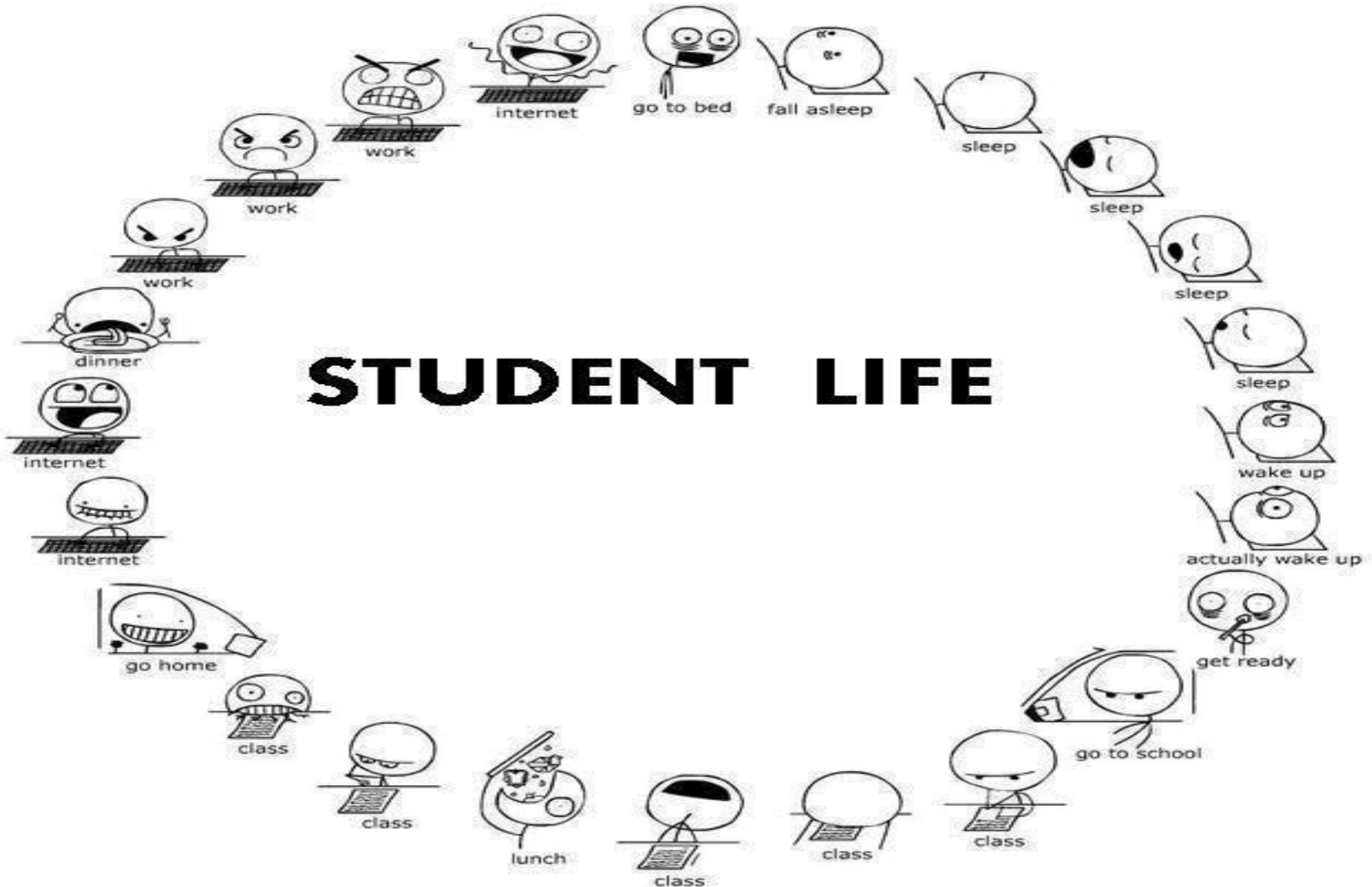

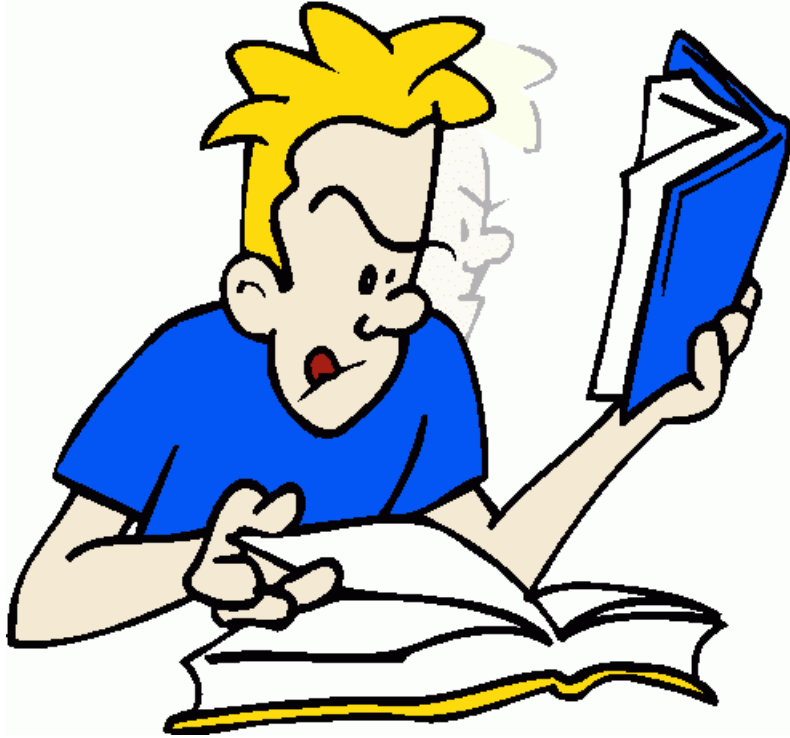


- The sector says that the Student **Experience is important and is** recognised as a metric by which Universities and all HEIs can be measured.
- To the consumers (students) it is the most important metric!
- **NUS = National Union of Student** first ever in-depth report on the Student Experience in November 2008
- An overview of **students' experiences across the UK**, looking at all areas of their lives, from the quality of their courses and accommodation, to their financial situations and experience of employment.
- The **main theme** of the report is university social life and meeting new people

- The **Times Higher Education** paper **provides reports /survey** for each academic year across the sector
- “Good Social Life” & “Good Students’ Union” are **top priorities**
- Each University across the UK provides data on SE to recruit students
- The **learning experience** and **course content** are also often raised and no significant differences between different institution types

- All students are included: UK, EU, Erasmus, International

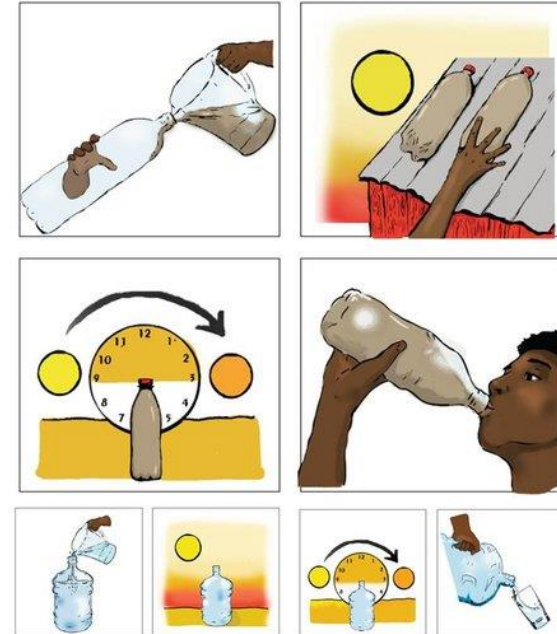


- ‘Max’, an ERASMUS+ participant secures a job with well know Italian car manufacturer – secured thanks to Erasmus study mobility in Italy.
